

## The Holy Island of Lindsfarne






635 CE: King St. Oswald of Northumbria asks St. Aidan to build a monastery

#### 793 CE: Vikings attack! Start of the Age of Vikings




- 1200 CE: 2<sup>nd</sup> monastery built
